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For many years, Tarrant County Precinct Number 1 has assisted the City of Benbrook with its annual street overlay program. Without this assistance, the overlay program would be significantly more expensive.

For fiscal year 2019/2020, \$700,000 was budgeted for this program. Under the Interlocal Agreement, the County will furnish labor and equipment necessary to overlay various streets throughout the City with two inches of asphalt. The City pays for the materials, prepares the streets and provides traffic control. This year's program will overlay approximately 3.49 miles of streets. The program is tentatively scheduled to begin in the spring 2020.

**Financing**

\$600,000 from the General Fund and \$100,000 from the Road Damage Fund will be used to fund the 2020 Overlay Program. The Road Damage Fund is part of the gas well permitting process. This fund is used to repair streets damaged by the gas well traffic.
